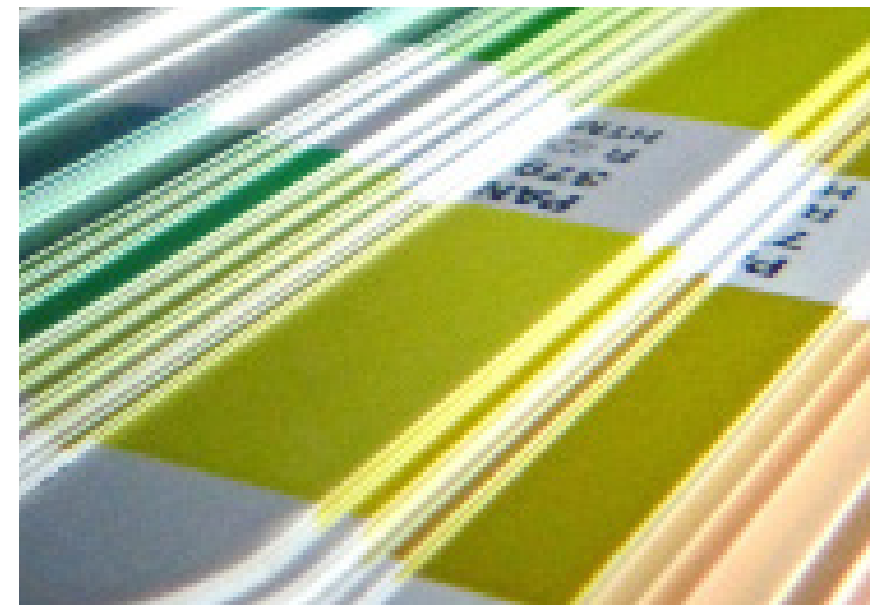


All our timber is certified from well managed sources, with full FSC® 100% accreditation.

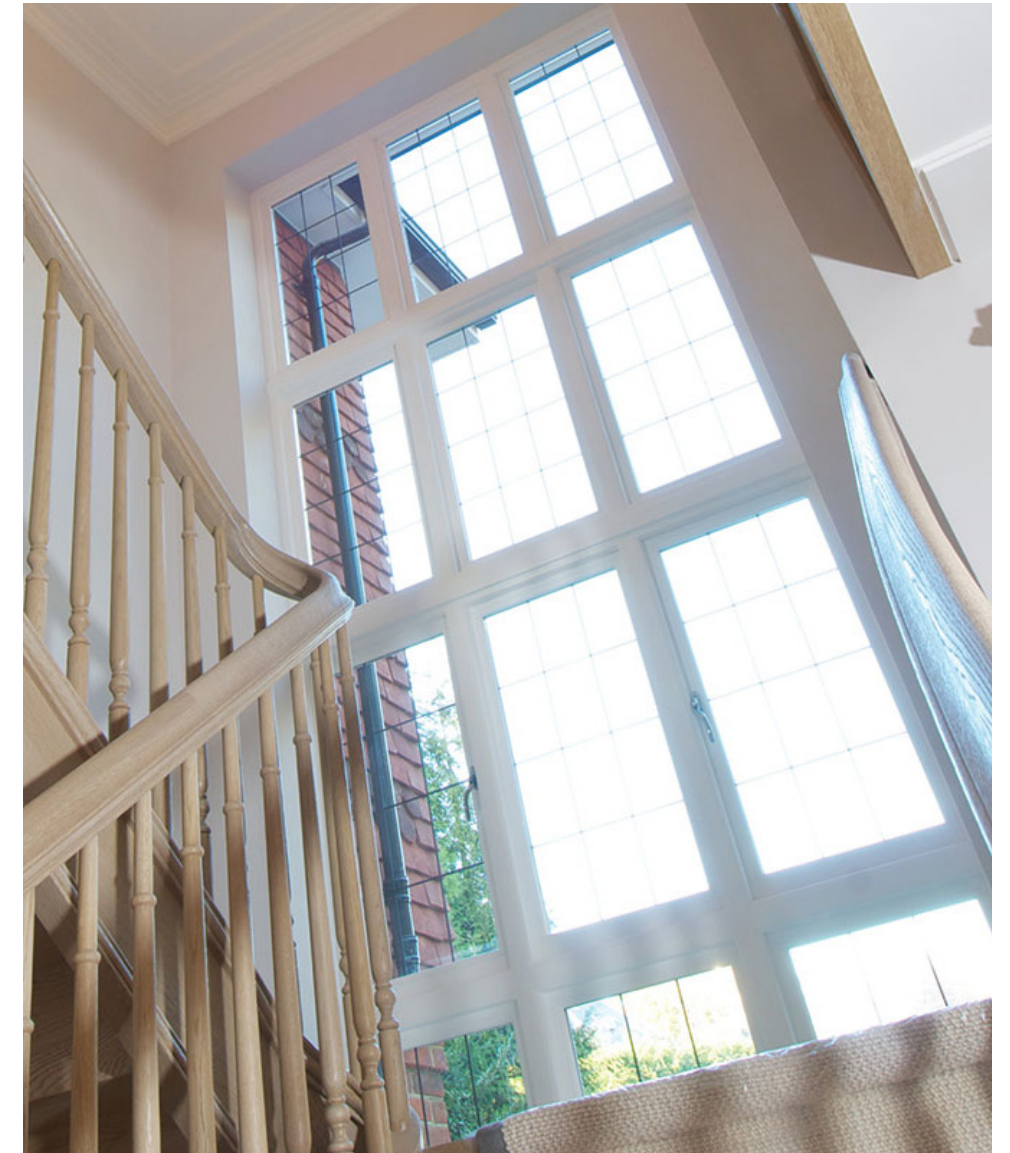

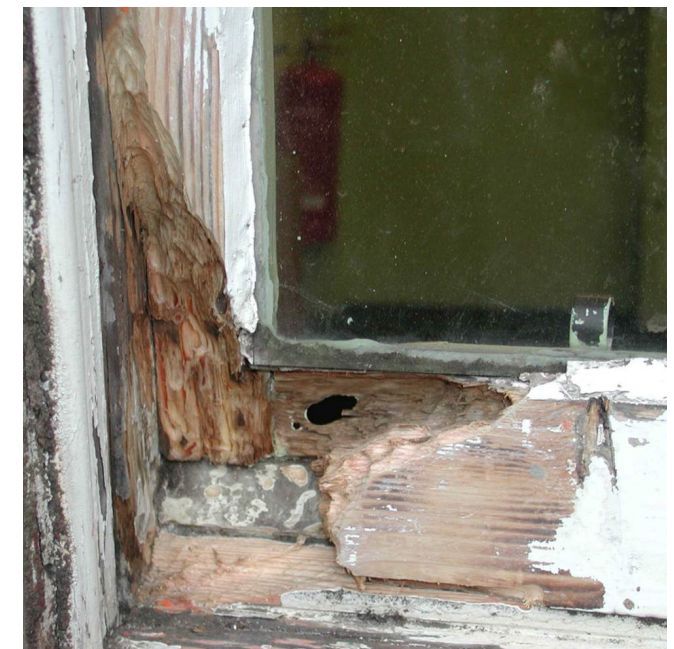

IWP Dansk refurbished the existing sliding sash windows, new timber windows and secondary glazing and all of the new bespoke doors on this student and residential grade II listed building in Durham.

Using our expertise and experience in heritage and listed window repair, we carefully restored the existing windows and manufactured the secondary glazing to the listed section of this building.

The second phase also included the manufacture of new sliding sash windows and three large period bay windows to match into the surrounding conservation area. This project also included the supply of new timber fire doors to the student block and moulded solid oak doors to the residential block.





Listed buildings

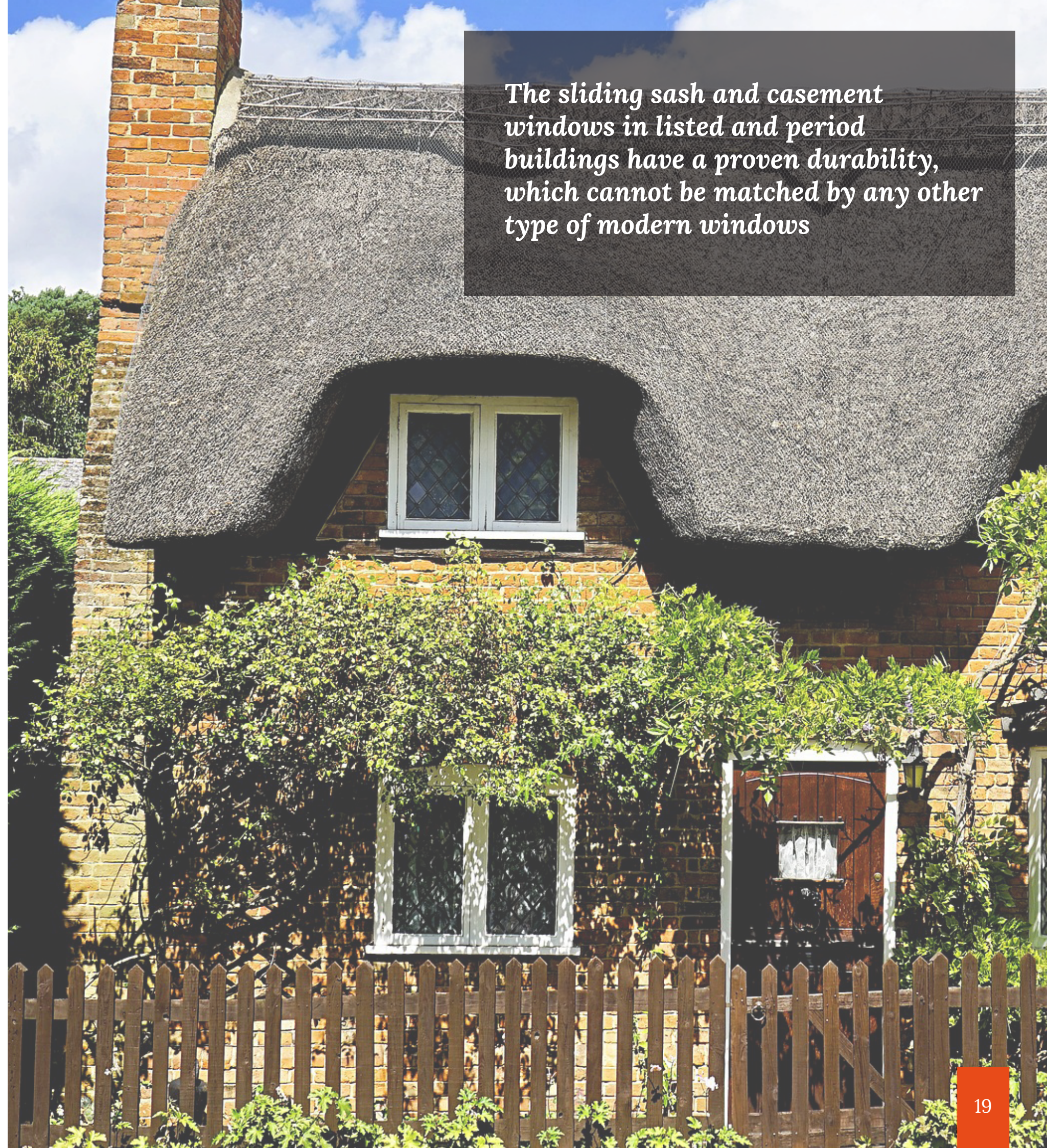

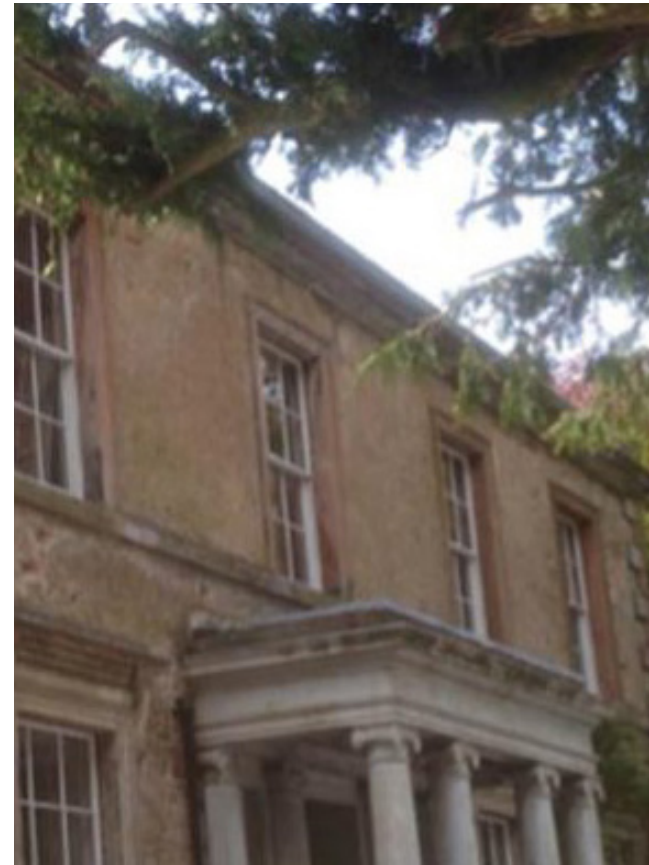

Warcop House

Warcop House is a large 13 bedroom grade II listed Georgian property, located in the historic Cumbrian village of Warcop.

Dating from the 19th Century, the main house with its imposing portico pillared entrance, had its first floor windows originally refurbished by us prior to the whole site being put on the market. This included repairing and draught-proofing, reprinting and redecorating all first floor windows, the biggest challenge being the replacement of the head on the arched stained glass window.

IWP Dansk has now been invited to help further restore the 250 year old house by repairing and restoring the original sash windows in order to give the property a new lease of life for the 21st Century.

Draught proofing

Sash windows play a central role in the character of any period property but are prone to draught and rattling.

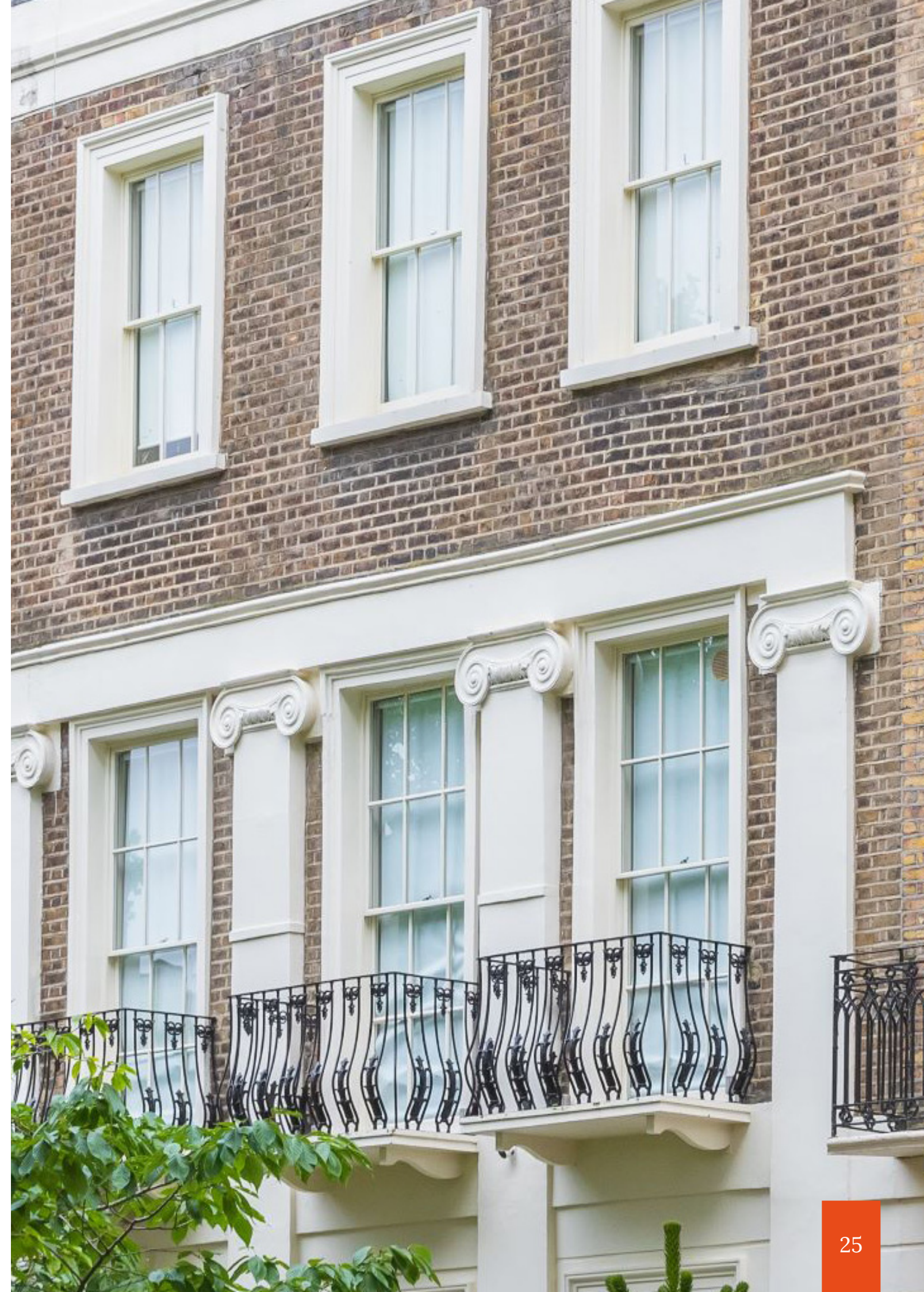
Architectural ironmongery
